Key take-aways

- California has a short-term plan & >\$350 million
- Secretary Crowfoot & the governor are committed to action – now have political will
- What we need now are results and projects in the ground.
 - Should not mean public needs to choose between projects and ongoing evaluations/research – it's too important of an issue to not generate support for both
- Some want answers on an import plan

- There are vibrant local communities that need to be an integral part of planning and long-term vision for the Sea.
- Despite decades of research, we continue to learn more about the changing Salton Sea
- The community wants more transparency & information
